Scholarship Application Deadline: June 12, 2009

Florida Agri-Women is accepting applications from female high school, undergraduate, and graduate students. Florida Agri-Women established these scholarships to continue its commitment to agriculture in the state of Florida. Applicants must be a resident of the state of Florida (have lived in the state of Florida for one year) and planning to or currently majoring in an agriculture related field of study at a Florida university.

Specific requirements include a minimum 3.5 GPA, U.S. citizenship, Florida residency and a plan for study in any agriculture discipline at a Florida university. The applicant must be a female high school senior accepted for undergraduate study or current undergraduate or graduate/professional student. Selection will be based on the above requirements and the candidate's career plans, potential for academic and profession success, and involvement in campus, professional, and community life.

Please attach these three items to the typed application:

1. Current official transcript.
2. Transcripts from other universities (for undergraduate or graduate/professional students).
3. Two letters of recommendation from two professors or high school teachers.

Award recipients will be presented with their scholarship award at the Florida Agri-Women's 6th Annual Founder's Day Dinner, which will be held Saturday, August 15, 2009 at 6:30pm at the Embassy Suites Lake Buena Vista, Orlando, Florida.
